**Pre-planning for bushfire season is integral to keeping your family and property safe if you are in the line of a fire. Because winds can easily change the course of a bushfire, it's very important to be prepared beforehand.**


Some important tips to keep in mind when putting your plan together.

## Preparation is essential

- Make a plan. Meet with family members and discuss what your plan of action will be and write it down.
- Fire danger ratings. Understand what each category means and use that as your trigger to stay or leave. Do not wait and see. On days that are forecasted for catastrophic or extreme fire danger, your safest and best option is to leave early.
- A safer place. If you reside in or intend to travel to a high-risk bushfire region, make sure that you know the location of the nearest Neighbourhood Safer Place, meeting point or evacuation centre to how to get there. Neighbourhood Safer Places are places of last resort. They may save your life, but they do not guarantee safety.

You can find these spots on your state or territory fire agency's website.

- Protecting the vulnerable. As early as possible, the elderly, children and animals should be moved away from the danger well before a fire arrives.
- Tell someone. Always notify your family and friends of your plans, your whereabouts, and your planned route and destination.
- Survival Kit. Make sure you have assembled a bushfire survival kit, you know where it is, and it is ready to go at a moment's notice.
- Stay informed. Follow your local news provider via radio and social media platforms and check with your state or territory's emergency services.
